



Hazardous Waste Management

Waste that is flammable, corrosive, reactive, or toxic is hazardous waste.

Label (must include)

- The words “Hazardous Waste”
- The hazards clearly marked
- A list of contents AND percentages (e.g., HCl 20% and Water 80%)
- Contact the Safety Coordinator if you need labels.

Ensure container is closed and correctly labeled before pickup request/pickup.

Store

- Keep waste in the room in which it was generated, with the lid on.
- Establish a storage area in your lab.
- Liquid waste should be stored in spill trays.
- Keep incompatible wastes separate.



Dispose

- Follow the link in the QR code to submit a Hazardous Waste Pickup Request or go to EHS.unm.edu
- Be available to provide access to the containers when Environmental Health & Safety (EHS) arrives on Wednesdays.
